	Secrets of Time (\$20.00). (For spiral-bound book, please check here). The revelation of
	timing, as revealed in the Scriptures and in history. It reveals the importance of October 1986 as the 120th Jubilee from Adam and the legal declaration of the Jubilee in fall of 1996.
	<b>Creation's Jubilee</b> (20.00). This is based upon the concept of the Jubilee and how this law applies
	to God's right of ownership of the earth.
	The Laws of the Second Coming (\$18.00). (For spiral-bound book, please check here). A thorough study of Israel's feasts and their prophetic significance to the second coming of Christ. Most Christians know that Passover showed the timing of Christ's death on the cross in His first appearance; but few understand the meaning of Trumpets, the Day of Atonement, and the Feast of Tabernacles. This book also teaches the laws of Sonship and the Manchild.
	<b>The Genesis Book of Psalms</b> (\$15.00). The psalms were divided into five books by the ancient rabbis—one for each of the books of Moses. This is study of the first 41 psalms called the Genesis Book of Psalms.
	The Biblical Meaning of Numbers from One to Forty (\$10.00).
	The Wars of the Lord, A Short History of Spiritual Warfare in Our Time (\$20.00). This 255-page book gives 51 short chapters summarizing the spiritual warfare that I experienced (1981-2008).
	<b>Lessons from Church History</b> (\$15.00), Volume 1. This gives a short history of the Church from the apostles to the Roman War, including Luke's account of Paul's journeys in the book of Acts. It includes Paul's fourth missionary journey to Spain and Britain.
	<b>Lessons from Church History</b> (\$20.00), Volumes 2-4. This is the history of the Church from the Roman War (66-73 A.D.) to Constantine and the Council of Nicea in 325 A.D. with lessons to be learned from it.

	<b>James to the Twelve Tribes: Faith and its Fruit</b> (\$15.00) Many in the past have wrestled with the supposed conflict between James and Paul over the issue of law and faith. Both agree that faith needs "fruit" to be considered genuine.

	<b>The Revelation: Book 1</b> (\$15.00). A study of Revelation 1-2.

Short Books
 <b>Daniel's Seventy Weeks: How it Shapes Modern Eschatology</b> (\$5.00). The 70 <sup>th</sup> week of Daniel is misunderstood in most prophecy teaching today. This has led to a multitude of incorrect assumptions about the events surrounding the second coming of Christ.
 <b>The Restoration of All Things</b> (\$4.00). The Bible says that every knee will bow to Jesus Christ and that God has committed to Jesus all judgment. How will God accomplish this purpose? Will He do this by refusing to judge mankind for sin? Or will He restore all things through His judgments?
 <b>The Jubilee</b> (3.00). This study on the law of Jubilee, and its prophetic significance, is in two chapters. The first is from Bill Britton. The second is chapter 7 of my book, <u>Creation's Jubilee</u> .
<b>The Judgments of the Divine Law</b> (\$5.00). This book devotes a separate chapter to each of the words translated "hell" in the NT: Tartarus, Gehenna, and Hades. It also deals with the biblical nature of the "lake of fire" and its duration as <i>eonian</i> . It concludes with a historical chapter showing what many of the early Church fathers believed.
<b>Who is a Jew?</b> (\$3.00) In Romans 2:28, 29 Paul tells us who IS a Jew and who is NOT a Jew. God's answer to this question cannot be obtained by looking at one's genetics, but the lawful requirements of citizenship in the Kingdom.
 <b>Who is an Israelite?</b> (\$5.00). This 60-page book is a natural sequel to the book, <u>Who is a Jew?</u> It traces the natural Israelites (i.e., ex-Israelites of the dispersion) from Israel to Assyria and on into Europe and elsewhere.
 <b>The Purpose of Resurrection</b> (\$2.50). If men receive their "eternal rewards" when they die, then what is the purpose of resurrection?
 <b>The Barley Overcomers</b> (\$3.00). This is an in-depth study of events in the Bible that occurred at the time of barley harvest (Wave-sheaf offering).
 <b>The Wheat and Asses of Pentecost</b> (\$3.00). Whenever wheat or asses are mentioned in the Bible, it speaks of Pentecost. We must move beyond Pentecost into Tabernacles and Sonship.
 <b>The Laws of Wormwood and Dung</b> (\$2.50). Ezekiel shows us that this is really a law regarding heart idolatry. This law is closely related to the subject of Wormwood, or opium.
 <b>Principles of Intercession</b> (\$3.00). All are called to pray, but God calls some to intercession. This book explains the three phases of intercession, using Jesus as the great Example. We are called to follow in His steps.
 <b>Hearing God's Voice</b> (\$3.00). What it means biblically and experientially to hear the voice of God and to walk in the Spirit of revelation, and avoid hearing the idols of the heart.
 <b>The Purpose of the Wilderness</b> (\$2.00). It explains why God calls some out of the Church for a season in order to teach them new things, so that they can return with a fresh word.
 <b>The Laws of Spiritual Warfare</b> (\$4.00). A study of the laws of war found in Deuteronomy 20. These laws have application in the area of spiritual warfare as well as physical warfare, for Paul says that the law is spiritual.
 The Two Covenants (\$3.00). A study of the differences between the two covenants.
 <b>Old and New Covenant Marriage</b> (\$4.00). The Bible recognizes two types of marriage in the law: marriage of a bond slave and marriage of a free woman. This is illustrated by Abraham's two wives, Hagar and Sarah. The Old and New Covenants are based upon these two types of marriages.
 The Bible Says: Divorce and Remarriage is NOT Adultery (\$3.00). This is a sequel to <u>Old and New Covenant Marriage</u> . Divorce itself is not necessarily a sin, but a judgment for sin.
<b>God's Law on Restitution</b> (\$2.50). This is a study of the 8th Commandment regarding theft of property. This includes a unique history of the failure of the American penal system.

<b>Bible Laws on Righteous Judgment</b> (\$3.00). This is a study of the 9th Commandment. The book also has a unique section on God's Supreme Court and a very important section on "God's True Method of Subduing the Earth."
 <b>Free Will vs. Ownership</b> (\$4.00). There has always been disagreement between those who believe in free will and those who believe that God is sovereign. The real issue is about God's ownership.
<b>The Problem of Evil</b> (\$3.00). Why does God allow evil to occur on earth? Is God an innocent bystander? This explores the difference between the will and plan of God and between God's sovereignty and man's authority.
 When REALLY Was Jesus Born? (\$2.00) The fascinating history of Jesus' birth.
 How to Be an Overcomer (\$3.00). Four basic lessons and an epilogue on what the Bible teaches.
<b>The Prophetic History of the United States</b> (\$3.00). This book devotes each chapter to specific important dates in the history of the USA, beginning with Columbus' arrival to the New World.
